NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH:--

1. The name of the Trust shall be SAINT JOHN'S EDUCATIONAL TRUST, functioning at No. 4, Hind Trust Lane St, Mandavelipakkam, Madras-28.
2. The objects of the Trust in General are
  - (a) To establish, found, organise, start, promote, construct, maintain, run, develop and improve educational Institutions such as Primary and Elementary Schools, Secondary or Higher Grade Schools, Colleges Polytechnics, Balwadis, Research Institutes, Scientific Cultural, Art, Technical or Vocational Training Institutions, Hostels etc., for students without distinction of caste, creed or religion.

(b) To provide for scholarships, meals, medical relief, books, accommodation, clothing and monetary help to deserving, needy, helpless and destitute children.

(c) To give donations for other educational institutions and for objects similar to those herein contained.

(d) To apply for and get affiliations and recognition from Universities, Educational Bodies and Departments of Governments.

(e) To promote spiritual, literary, educational, cultural and scientific progress of all especially the student community.

3. The funds of the Trust hereinbefore conveyed will form a corpus to which shall accrue all future accretions, profits, incomes, donations and properties that may be earned or received in due course.

4. The SETTLORS are the founder trustees and they will constitute the Board of Trust for the time being and they will nominate one more Trustee among the public. The Board of Trustee shall be 3 and maximum 5.

If and whenever the number of Trustees shall be reduced to below 3, the continuing Trustee/Trustees shall appoint such number of new Trustee/Trustees as shall be required.

5. In case of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the same shall be filled up by nomination by the remaining Trustee/Trustees.

6. The Trustees shall at no time be entitled to appropriate to themselves any revenues of the Trust except that they may be reimbursed any actual expenditures incurred by them on behalf of the Trust and they also be entitled to receive a modest remuneration for actual services rendered to the Trust.

7. The Trustees shall have power:-

- (a) To receive and to accept contributions, donations and gifts in money or property of any kind either by way of additional to the Trust Funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust and such contributions shall be dealt with either as capital or as income according to the directions of the Donors at the time of the gift or contributions and the Trustees shall do all things as may be necessary to act upto the wishes of such Donors;
- (b) To receive and accept any business or businesses or manufacturing units as donation to the Trust and to run the same for the aforesaid purposes of the Trust;
- (c) To invest moneys and properties of the Trust in one or more of the following:-

- (i) In the purchase of lands and building or in the construction of buildings where the Trustees are satisfied that such investment will yield a reasonable income or where it is deemed expedient or necessary for carrying out the objects of the Trust;
  - (ii) In fixed deposits with any Bank, Company or Corporation;
  - (iii) In the investment of funds in any industry, agriculture, dairy farming, fruit, flower or vegetable nursery, trade, business as the Trustees may deem proper;
  - (iv) In investing the same with any private Banker or Bankers in whom the Trustees have confidence and belief;
- (d) From time to time and at any time to call in and convert or otherwise dispose of the Trust properties and realise all or any of the securities, investments, and assets of the Trust and reinvest or utilise the same in such manner as they may deem fit;
- (e) Over the management of the Trust and its properties and funds they shall have full control over the finance of the Trust. They shall likewise be entitled to take all steps that may be reasonable or required for the preservation of the Trust and the Trust properties and the title of the Trust to

the Trust properties;

(f) To apply for and obtain grants or loans from the Government, Local Authorities, or other Authorities, Banks, Companies, Firms, Individuals and institutions on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in regard to security and interest and shall for this purpose be entitled to secure such mortgage or charge on the properties, of the Trust as may be necessary;

(g) To frame necessary rules and regulations for proper and convenient administration of the Trust and to act according to such approved rules and regulations;

(h) For the purpose of fulfilling the aims and objects of the institutions to raise loans, donations, subscriptions and financial help and to get financial help through Local institutions and State and Central Governments and other institutions.

(i) To keep and manage the accumulated funds for the aims and objects of the institutions;

(j) To buy or take on lease or exchange or on tenancy or grant immovable properties, for the requirements and convenience of the Trust;

(k) To sell, develop, manage and improve the whole or part of the Trust Funds.

8. Investments and documents of title shall be made and taken in the name of the Trust itself.

9. The Bank account or accounts of the Trust shall be opened in its own name and operated by all the Trustees jointly and/or severally for and on behalf of the Trust.

10. The Trustees may meet together for the despatch of the business of the Trust as and when they think fit.

11. Minute books shall be regularly maintained for the Resolutions passed at the meeting of the Trustees present.

12. The Trustees shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper account of all receipts and payments and for proper audit of the accounts of the Trust, every year.

13. No immovable properties are belonged to the Trust as the schools mentioned above are run on rental basis.

14. The movable assets belonged to the Schools such as benches are of the value of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand and five hundred only) including the deposited amount of Rs. 101/- in the Bank.
